OPERATIONS ORDER
2006 Florida Wing Summer Encampment

TO: ALL CADET/COMPOSITE UNITS

1. **MISSION:** The Florida Wing will conduct its "Summer Encampment", from Saturday 24 June 2006 – Saturday 1 July 2006. The activity will take place at Camp Blanding, Starke Florida.

2. **DURING THE ACTIVITY:** All members will be expected to act in an appropriate manner during the course of the activity. Staff members will be expected to carry out the responsibilities which are assigned to them. Any disciplinary problems will be handled by the Encampment Commander, with repercussions, potentially including non-credit for the encampment or dismissal from the activity. Any member dismissed from the activity will be responsible for securing transport home immediately. Cadets should advise their parents that there is little time available for personal phone calls during the activity. Phone calls will not be allowed during the activity unless under special circumstances and with the approval of the Encampment Commander.

3. **FIRST-TIME CADET (DOOLIE) APPLICATION PROCEDURE:** Cadets who are members by June 1st 2006 are eligible to attend the activity provided they have earned the Curry achievement prior to activity start. First-time cadets should have a basic working knowledge of drill and ceremonies, customs and courtesies and uniform wear. Application procedure is as follows: FLWGF 500 (picture not needed), \$150 check (made payable to **Florida Wing HQ**),. Application deadline is **1 June 2006** postmark.

4. **CADET STAFF APPLICATION PROCEDURE:** C/TSgt or higher and have previously attended an encampment are eligible to apply for cadet staff. Cadet staff hopefuls are required to attend Encampment Cadet Command Staff School, and should use that Operations Order for all applications.

5. **SENIOR STAFF APPLICATION PROCEDURE:** Seniors wishing to participate on staff should e-mail Lt Col Trammell as to your intentions tom@dkeinc.com. Submit CAPF 17, \$150 check (made payable to **Florida Wing HQ**). Senior Staff Application deadline is 1 June 2006 postmark.

If seniors are interested in a specific position, please list on your CAPF 17 and state that in your e-mail to Lt Col Trammell.

6. **ALL APPLICANTS:** Applications must be legible and complete; any application that is illegible or incomplete will be returned. **PLEASE INCLUDE A VALID E-MAIL ADDRESS WHERE YOU CAN BE REACHED FOR CONFIRMATIONS.** Please waive the signature requirement if you use special mail, i.e., Fed Ex. overnight, etc. Please do not mail to the Wing mailing address. This will delay processing the application and could result in losing a slot for the activity. 7. **COST:** The cost of the encampment for all participants is \$150.00.

8. **TRANSPORTATION:** Transportation to and from such activity is not the responsibility of CAP and is provided "as available" Privately owned vehicles travel to or from such activity is performed strictly at the members' own risk (reference CAPR 77-1, para 6c and CAPR 52-16, para 8-10) and is not under CAP direction and control.

10. **REPORTING TIMES:** First-time cadet (doolie) registration will begin on Saturday, 24 June. 2006, participants must arrive between 1300 and 1430. (EAT LUNCH BEFORE YOU ARRIVE) On Saturday 1 July 2006, Pass-in-Review will begin at 1030. Out-processing will begin immediately following the Pass-in-Review.

Uniforms:

Blues

One (1) blue uniform (2 uniforms if possible)
Air Force flight cap / hat device
Air Force belt with buckle
One pair well broken-in black low quarter shoes
4 "V" neck white T-shirts
4 pair black socks / hoses (neutral)
8 pair underclothing
Ribbons / cutouts, name tag
Air Force neck tie (optional)

BDU's

One (1) set of BDU's (2 uniforms if possible)
Air Force belt with subdued buckle for BDU's
5 brown / tan / black T-shirts for BDU's
5 pair heavy black socks
1 pair well broken-in black jump boots (if possible)
Web belt with canteen

BEDDING

Linens will be provided, however you should bring your own pillow.

Misc. items

2 towels/wash cloth sets
Gym Clothes
6 pair white gym socks
Running shoes
Shower shoes
Personal toiletries (soap, deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, brush)

12-inch ruler

- Medication (Notify medical officer upon arrival), this includes all “over-the-counter” medications of any kind.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Do not bring – Cell phones (cadets), I-pods, radios, games, playing cards, knives, toys, candy, food, fireworks, electronic games, weapons of any kind, pagers / beepers, alcohol or tobacco products. Any items on this list or any additional items determined by the encampment staff to be inappropriate for encampment use will be secured for the duration of the activity and returned to the cadet after dismissal from the activity. You should not bring any non-CAP books.

Any cadet bringing a privately-owned vehicle will be required to secure the vehicle and turn in the keys to the encampment staff. This includes cadet staff members. If you drive your personal vehicle, be sure to bring proof of insurance, license and registration.

Do not report in before the scheduled reporting time.
