SUBJECT: CAPR 60-4 Rescinded

The National Executive Committee directed that CAPR 60-4, Volume I, Part I, Volume I, Part II, and Volume II be rescinded once necessary changes were made to training documents, programs and online services. These changes have been made and the Operations Committee feels it is now time to rescind CAPR 60-4.
